



New Mexico Health Connections/ OptumRx Infusion Services Site-of-Care Program Fact Sheet

Beginning **September 1, 2019**, New Mexico Health Connections (NMHC) members who receive certain infused medications will be required to use the site-of-care partner, **OptumRx® Infusion Services**.

Physicians providing infusion therapy of these drugs in an **outpatient-hospital setting** will need to transition members to OptumRx Infusion Services. ***However, infusions provided in the provider office setting will still be permitted and will NOT be impacted by this mandatory program.***
